- Subject to justification on reasonable criteria, to fund and implement energy efficiency improvement projects, and support the use of renewable energy usage
- Creating employee awareness through the provision of appropriate training
- Investigating all aspects of energy wastage and rectifying them if avoidable
- Making employees aware of the cost of energy directly under their control and encouraging good housekeeping practices
- Supporting national governmental energy efficiency policies

This policy will be

- Communicated to all employees, internal and external interested parties, and will be prominently displayed at all the designated areas
- Reviewed on an annual basis or when operating circumstances require it
